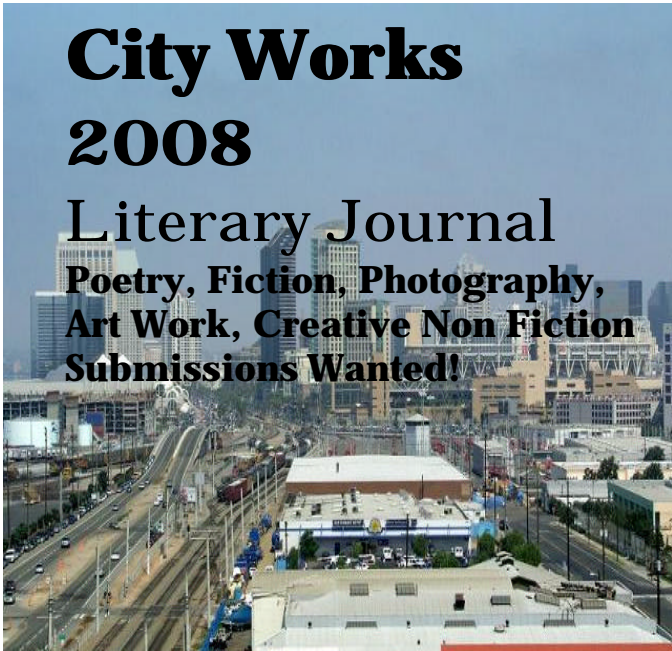

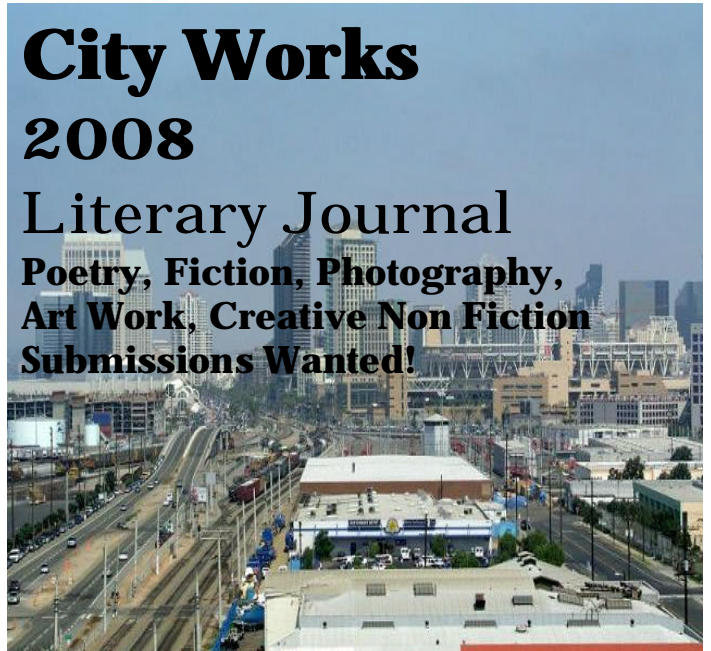

Beginning Feb. 23, 2007, *City Works* will accept the following submissions from students, staff and faculty at San Diego City College, from the San Diego community at-large and national writers and artists:

- ***Poems:** Maximum of 5
- ***Creative Nonfiction:** Up to 2,500 words, Maximum of 2
- ***Fiction:** Up to 2,500 words, Max. of 2
- ***Artwork:** A photocopy in black and white, 8 ½ x 11 of pen, ink, life drawings, illustrations, graphics, cartoons, computer-generated art, or photographs—max. of 5, originals required only upon acceptance

- All manuscripts must be typed.
- All work must be original (non-English submissions must include English translations).
- Do not put your name on your manuscript.

On-campus entries must have **this** *City Works* entry form. Please place your submissions in the *City Works* mailbox in the mailroom, A-8.

Off-campus submissions do not need an entry form, but they must include a **\$5.00** reading fee. Please make checks payable to *City Works*, and simply mail your submission, including a cover letter with your name and phone number. Do not put your name on your manuscript.
